



## Richard W. Lisska "Dick"

Richard William (Dick) Lisska died May 18, 2018 after a lengthy illness. He was born to Florence Wolfel Lisska and Joseph A. Lisska on December 23, 1945 in Columbus, Ohio. After attending local parochial schools, he attained a metallurgy degree at Case Institute of Technology in Cleveland, Ohio.

Dick worked in the aluminum industry, studied architecture at Georgia Institute of Technology and earned a Masters of Business Administration at Georgia State University. For several decades he worked as a real estate asset manager and then as a tax consultant in later years.
